1. Write a set of instructions and clues for an Easter Egg Hunt around your home. Use words like; first, then, next, below, on top of, beside, next to, etc. If you don't want to use Easter Eggs you can use anything else for your hunt.
2. Plant some vegetables and keep a diary of how it grows. It is easier than it sounds. Take a slice of tomato or the roots of an onion and plant them in the soil. Make sure they are somewhere in the sun and have a small amount of water every day. If you would like some other fun learning activities to do here are some ideas:

1. Hard boil some eggs and paint them with a decoration. (You could also do this with stones if you don't want to use eggs.)
2. Papier-mache around a balloon to create an egg shape for decoration with paint, stickers, markers or anything else you might like. Follow this with a written description about what it looks like.
3. Dry out an egg shell and paint faces on them to create finger puppets.
4. In Design and Technology we were going to be making a salad so it would be great to see the children helping out in the kitchen to create a salad.
5. Create a poster for your front windows to support our NHS. The rainbow has been used as the symbol to show our support for the frontline workers.
