

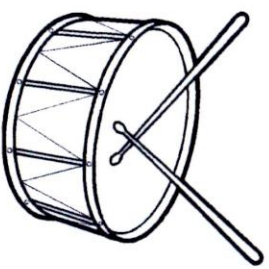
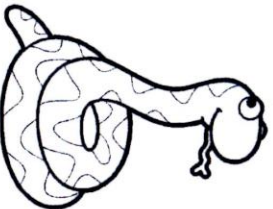
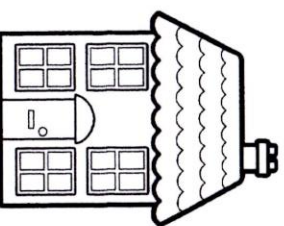
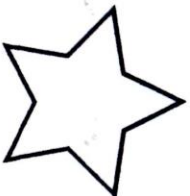
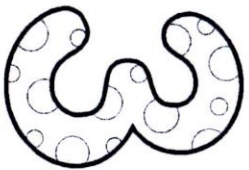
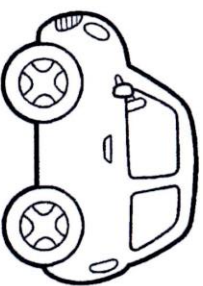
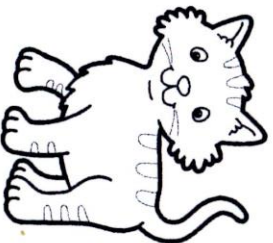
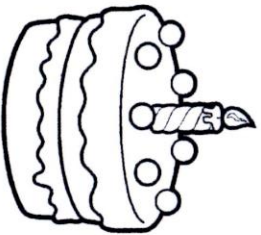


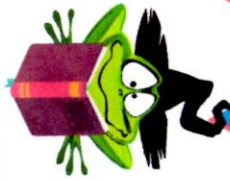
# Find the Rhyme

with a line.

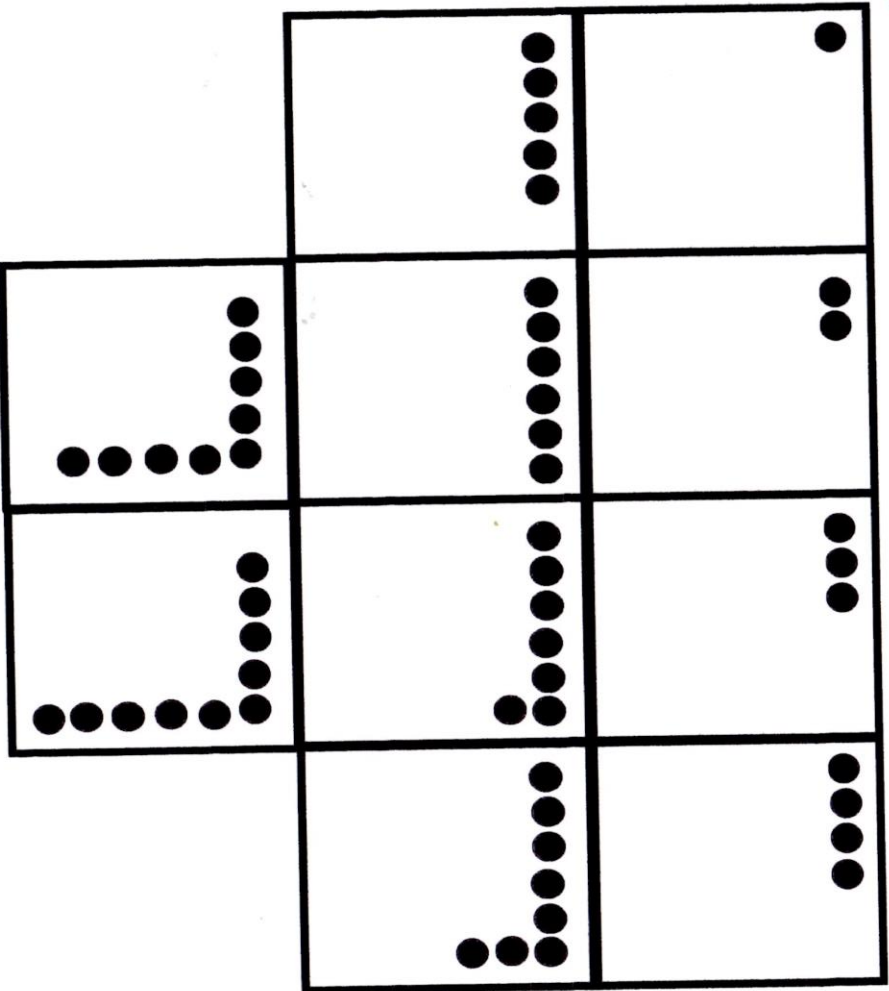
You will need:

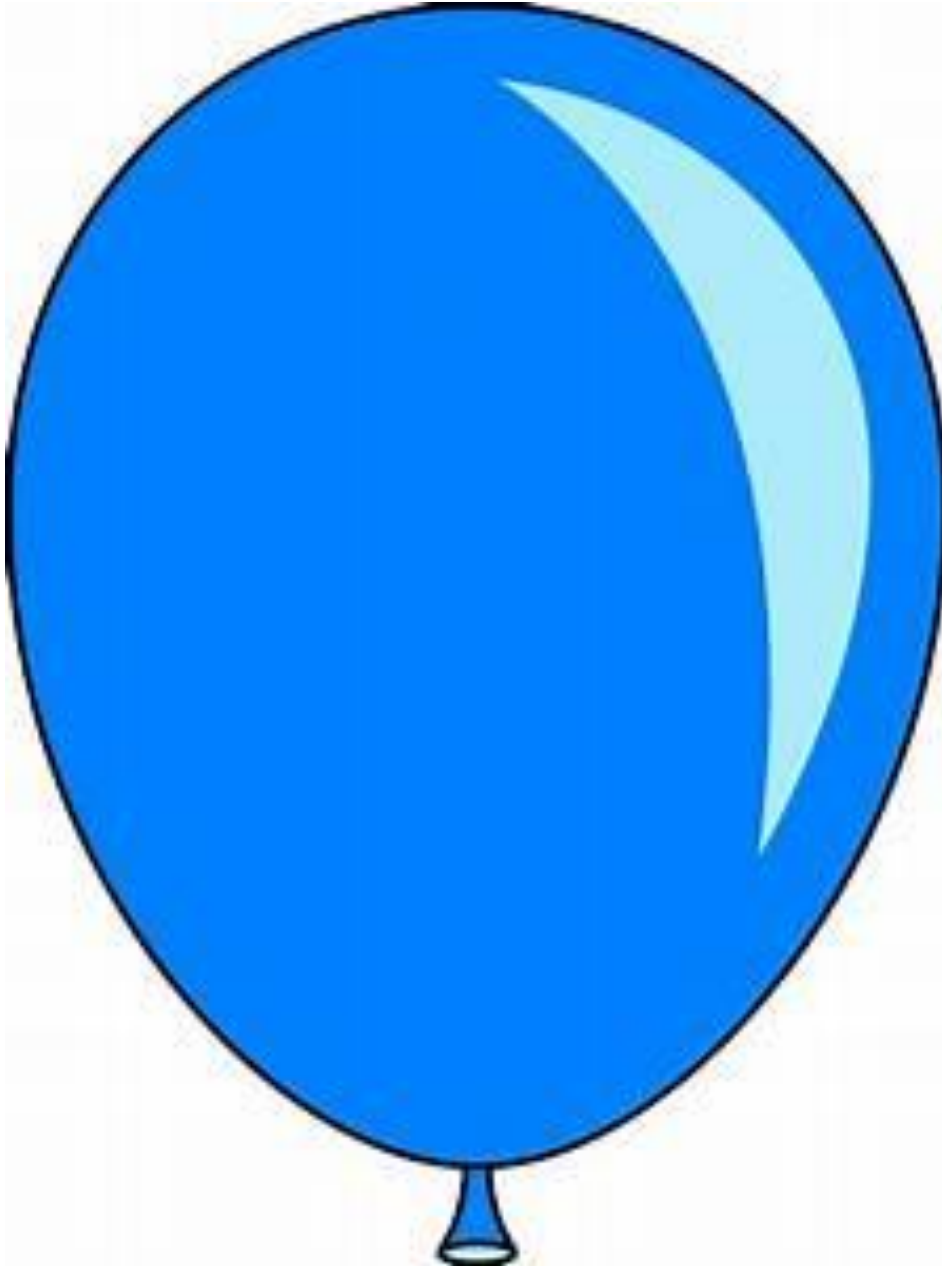
