<p>With a grown up helping, put some water into a small container or ice cube maker and put it in the freezer. Take container out of freezer next day. Talk about what has happened to the water. What does the water feel like now?</p>	<p>Remember to wash your hands after going to the toilet and when hands are dirty. Remember to sing Happy Birthday 2 times.</p> <p>Talk to your grown ups about why washing your hands is so important.</p>	<p>If you could make a wish, what would that wish be.</p> <p>Draw a picture about your wish and tell your grown up about your picture.</p> <p>Sheet provided if you would like to use it.</p>
<p>Concertina Fish Cut out a fish shape. Make it look very colourful. Fold it backwards and forwards. (concertina) Then add straws or sticks to its head and tail and make it wiggle.</p> <p>Instruction Sheet provided.</p>	<p>Close your eyes and ask a grown up to drop some coins or stones into a bowl or bucket of water.</p> <p>How many stones/coins did they drop into the water?</p> <p>Repeat several times.</p>	<p>Can you draw some fish in a fishbowl? You might try to draw a square fish or a circle fish or a triangle fish or a rectangle fish. You might like to give your fish some names.</p> <p>Sheet provided if you would like to use it.</p>
<p>Have a bowl or bucket of water. Choose some things to put into the water: stone sponge, tissue, ball, coin, toy boat. Before each object is put into the water talk to somebody about whether you think it will float or sink. Add the object to the water and talk about what does happen.</p>	<p>Share a story about water or fish with your grown up. Listen to the story The Fish who could Wish. On you Tube. https://youtu.be/sWb7KBT7KyA</p> <p>What would you wish for? What would other family members wish for?</p>	<p>Using a bowl of water or in the bath, use some containers for pouring and filling. Talk about whether the containers are full or empty.</p> <p>Can you fill a container, so it is half full?</p>
<p>Go on a shape hunt in the house and garden. Can you find a square, rectangle, circle, or triangle shaped object?</p> <p>Sheet provided if you would like to use it.</p>	<p>Put some small objects into a bowl of water that can float— leaves, feathers. Can you pick the things out of the water using tweezers or tongs or a clothes peg?</p>	<p>Watch Come Outside-Fish on You tube Auntie Mabel and Pippin will tell you all about fish. https://youtu.be/lZmkh7KXz2Y</p>
<p>Add some food colouring to a clear container of water. What is happening? Talk about the patterns and colours you can see.</p>	<p>Sing and dance along to the song Baby shark. https://youtu.be/XqZsoesa55w</p> <p>Sorry grown-ups.</p>	<p>Make a poster about washing your hands or colour the picture in and display it in your house to remind people to wash their hands regularly.</p> <p>Washing hands picture provided.</p>
