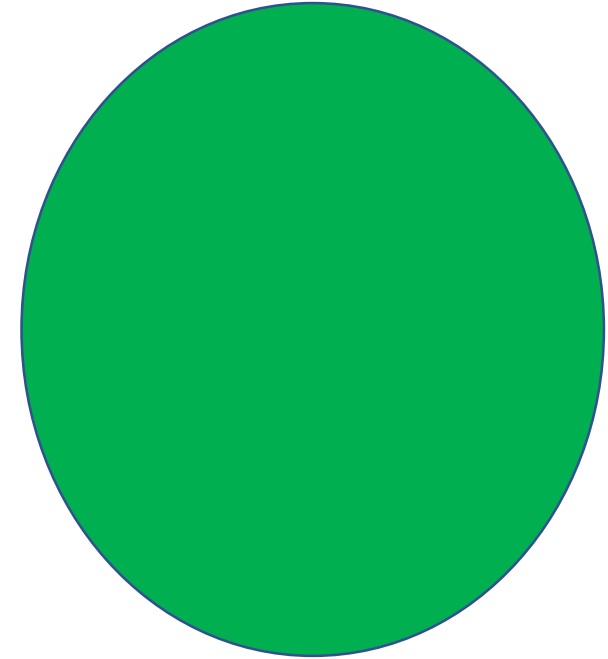
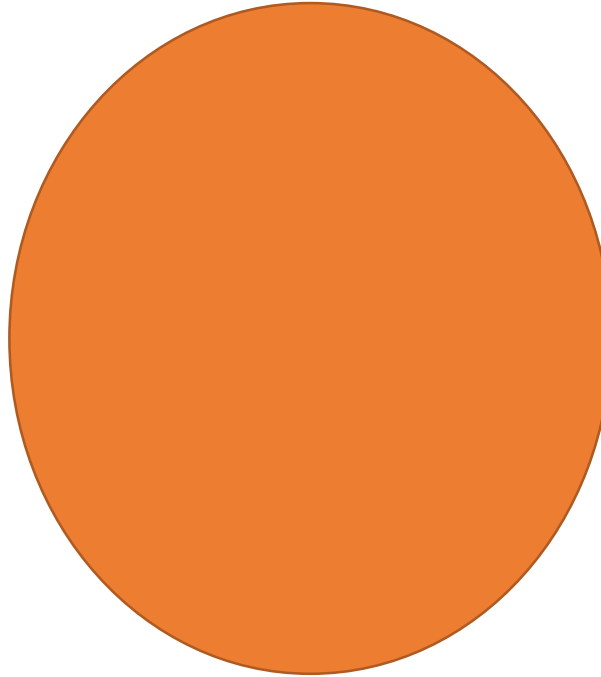
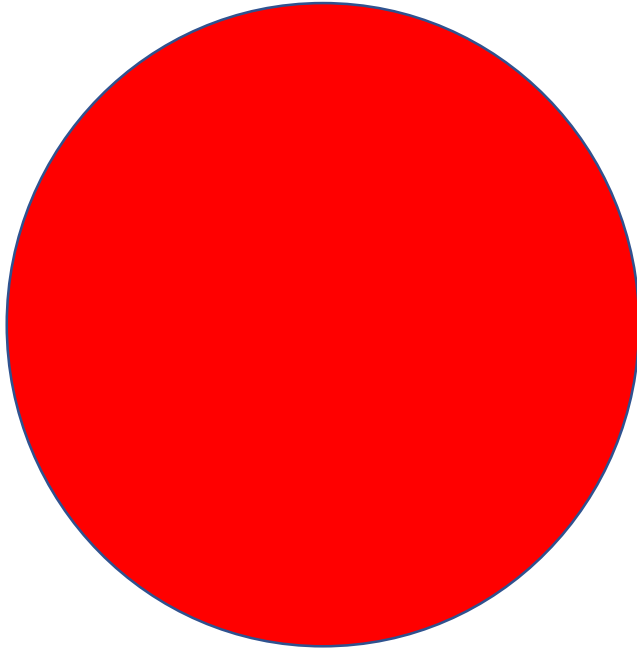






Traffic lights



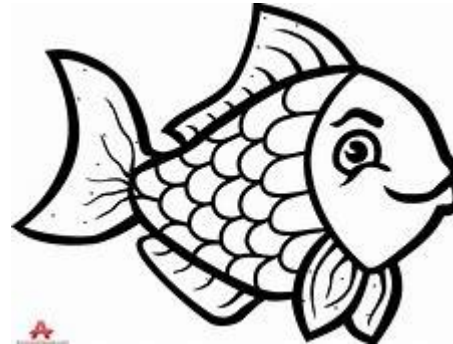
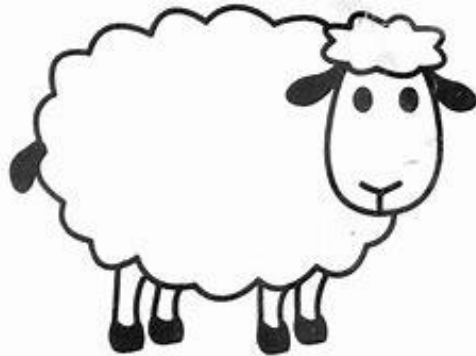
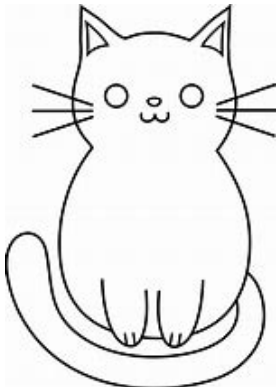
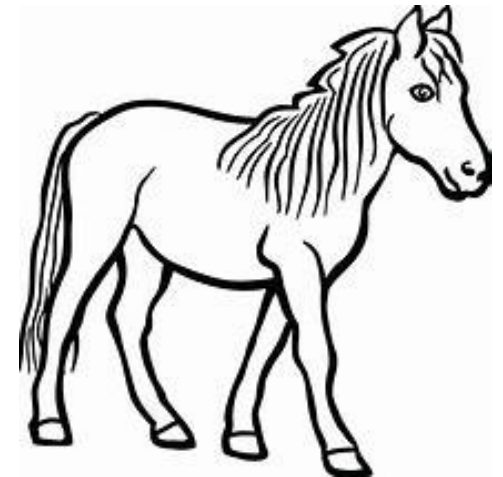
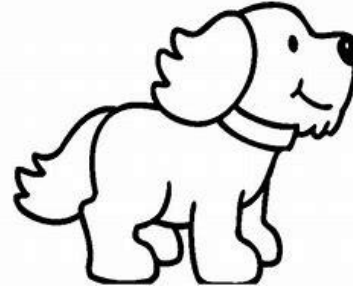
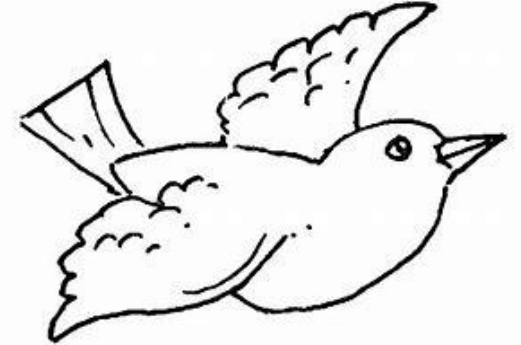
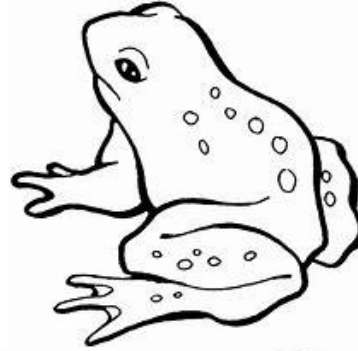
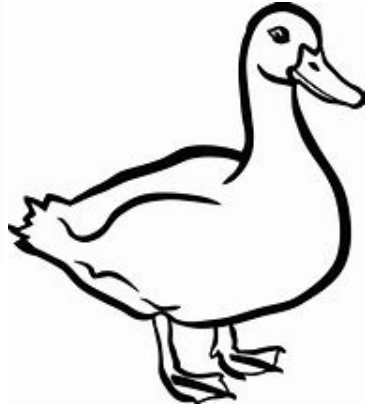
1. Adult cut out 3 circles.

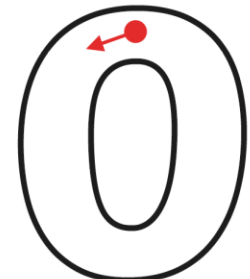
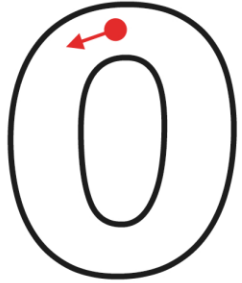
