





Activity	<p>Today we are going to learn a new sound. It's a triagraph. Can you remember what that means? (It's three letters together which make one sound). Today's sound is air as in fair, hair and pair. Ask an adult to write some words with the air sound. Can you read them?</p>	<p>Yesterday we learnt a new triagraph out loud. What words can you think of that contains the air sound? Today's sound is ure as in pure, cure and secure. Can you think of any more words with the ure sound? Can you write a list of ure words?</p>	<p>Can you remember the triagraph you learnt yesterday? Can you whisper it, now shout it and say it in a squeaky voice. Today's sound is er as in hammer, letter and dinner. Can you think of any more er words?</p>	<p>Let's start by reading some tricky words. (You could write these in foam, sand, glitter or paint ... it doesn't have to be pencil and paper)</p> <p>went they she and his</p> <p>The new sound today is ay as in day, play and spray.</p>	<p>Today we are going to apply our phonics learning to reading sentences. Clair at the Funfair




It was hot. Clair sat on a chair to put on a pair of red flip-flops.




Then, she brushed her short hair and put in a clip.

Gair had to finish at the fair, as his mum was waiting. He felt it was unfair, as Clair was still at the park. He might go back again the next day.



Write the words and then colour the ones with an 'ure' sound in them.




















Phase 3 er Sound Colouring Scene

Draw a picture that has the ay sound. 


