





Sound	or	ur	ow	oi	ear
Activity	<p>Today we are going to learn a new sound. It's a diagraph. Can you remember what that means? (Two letters together which make one sound). Today's sound is or as in corn, horn and born. Can you practise saying today's sound and then read the words above like a robot?</p>	<p>Can you remember the diagraph you learnt yesterday? Say it out loud. What words can you think of that contains the or sound? Today's sound is ur as in fur, surf and turnip. Can you think of any more words with the ur sound? Can you answer the silly questions? Can a dog surf? Do frogs have fur? Can you write some silly questions using ur words?</p>	<p>Can you remember the diagraph you learnt yesterday? Can you whisper it, now shout it and say it in a squeaky voice. Today's sound is ow as in owl, bow and town. Practise saying today's sound and read the words to an adult. Can you whisper, shout and say ow in a funny voice? Can you write a list of ow words?</p>	<p>The new diagraph today is as in oil, coin and tinfoil. Can you practise saying today's sound and reading the words? Can you or an adult write some oi words on paper and place them on the floor as though the paper is 'puddles' or stones'. Here are some more oi words:- boil, join, soil, toil, quoit and poison. Now spread the words out on the floor or outside. Encourage your child to hop onto a 'stone' or into a 'puddle' and read the word they have landed on.</p>	<p>Can you remember all of the sounds you have worked on this week? Say them out loud. Can you write them? The final sound is a trigraph can you remember what it is? (Its three letters that make one sound) Can you practise saying ear. Can you read the ear words? Dear, tear and beard.</p>



The Unicorn




Up in the north, near to York,
was a foal.




On a wet night, in a storm, the
foal was born.




A vet went to help.





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
