<p style="text-align: center;">Listen to the story Handa's Surprise on You tube.</p> <p>https://youtu.be/vBXDckTUf6c</p> <p>How did the tangerines get into the basket?</p>	<p>Look around your house. Can you find some fruits?</p> <p>What colour are the fruits? What do they feel like? What are they called?</p>	<p>Can you name and colour the fruits from the story?</p> <p style="text-align: center;">Sheet provided.</p>
<p style="text-align: center;">Handa carried the basket on her head.</p> <p>Can you balance a small cushion or bowl on your head and walk around without it falling off? Can other members of your family do it? Who can do it for the longest time?</p>	<p>Cut out the fruit pictures and arrange them in the basket.</p> <p style="text-align: center;">Sheet provided.</p>	<p>Choose a fruit and a bowl. Can you put the fruit: Under the bowl in the bowl Next to the bowl behind the bowl beside the bowl. Can somebody else put the fruit somewhere and you tell them where the fruit is?</p>
<p>Using a paper plate or a circle Create a basket. Draw some fruit onto the basket. Ask someone to write the names of the fruits you have drawn.</p> 	<p>Use tweezers or a clothes peg or tongs and some (20) small pieces of scrunched up paper to be pretend fruits. Pick up the pieces of paper using the peg or tweezers and place them into a bowl or basket. Count them as you put them in.</p>	<p>Handa gave her friend a gift. If you could give a gift to a friend, which friend would you choose? What gift would you give them? Draw a picture of you giving a gift to somebody.</p> <p style="text-align: center;">Sheet provided.</p>
<p>Create a chart showing the favourite fruit of your family. Ask each person what fruit they like and put it on your chart. Which fruit was the favourite? How do you know? Was there a fruit nobody chose?</p> <p style="text-align: center;">Sheet provided.</p>	<p>Handa counted 7 fruits into her basket. Can you count to 7? 10? 20? Can you write the numbers to 10? I have added the number sheet to practise again. Remember to use a different colour every day. Can you turn the sheet over and write them on your own?</p> <p style="text-align: center;">Sheet provided.</p>	<p>Watch Come Outside on You tube Auntie Mabel and Pippin will tell you all about apples.</p> <p>https://youtu.be/M7tYI2XLYxM</p>
<p>Count out 7 fruits or toys. If 1 is taken away, how many will be left? Count and see if you were right. Repeat until there are no fruits or toys left.</p>	<p>There were lots of animals in our story. Can you name the animals that were in our story?</p> <p style="text-align: center;">Sheet provided.</p>	<p>Can you remember the fruit that each of the animals took out of the basket? Which animal did not take a fruit? What did this animal do instead?</p> <p style="text-align: center;">Sheet provided.</p>
