| Sound | a-e | e-e | i-e | o-e | u-e |
| Activity | <p>Today we are going to work on split digraph. A split digraph also contains two letters (a-e, e-e, i-e, o-e and u-e) but they are split between a consonant, for example; make, bike and pure.</p> <p>The split digraph works by using an 'e' after the initial vowel to change the sound of the vowel. With a split digraph, tot turns into tote, hug to huge and tub to tube. Note the change in the sound of the first vowel from a hard sound to a longer softer sound, this is because of the 'e'.</p> | <p>Yesterday we learnt a new split digraph a-e. Today we are going to learn a new split digraph it is e-e as in these, Pete, even, complete and extreme. Can you think of any more e-e words? 
