<p>Listen to the story Whatever Next on You tube.</p> <p>https://youtu.be/20nbAy6gGkc</p> <p>Whoosh!</p>	<p>In our story the bear had a picnic.</p> <p>Choose a favourite bear or toy to take on a picnic with you. Think of a good place to have the picnic and prepare some food to take as well as a blanket to sit on. Have fun!</p>	<p>Cut, count, and order the space numbers from 1 to 10.</p> <p style="text-align: center;">Sheet provided.</p>
<p>Make a rocket of your own. You may use a box to create a big rocket or choose a cardboard tube to create a small rocket.</p> 	<p>Look out of the window or go outside, with a grown up, when it is dark.</p> <p>Talk about what you can see. Can you count the stars? Can you find the moon? Does the moon look the same every night? What sounds can you hear?</p>	<p>Bear went to the moon in a rocket.</p> <p>Can you cut out the rockets and order them by their size. Some are short and some are tall.</p> <p>Grown up's- use vocabulary tall and short.</p> <p style="text-align: center;">Sheet provided</p>
<p>Sing and dance to the song Zoom, zoom, zoom, we're going to the moon.</p> <p>https://youtu.be/RZG1YAzNHFA</p>	<p>Create a picture of a rocket using 2d shapes.</p> <p>Can you name the 2d shapes that you used to create your rocket.</p> <p style="text-align: center;">Sheet provided.</p>	<p>Write over the lines to help the rocket reach the moon. Remember to keep looking when you are following the line. Try to write some of the patterns without lines to help you.</p> <p style="text-align: center;">Sheet provided</p>
<p>When the teddy bear has the picnic on the moon is my favourite part of the story.</p> <p>Draw a picture about your favourite part of the story.</p> <p style="text-align: center;">Sheet Provided.</p>	<p>Watch Come outside with Auntie Mabel and Pippin. <p>Draw a spaceship on a paper plate. Draw some people in the spaceship.</p> <p>Toss your spaceship through the air.</p> <p>Mark where it lands. Can you make it fly further?</p> <p>Be careful it does not fly into somebody else's garden.</p>	<p>Explore using a torch.</p> <p>What does the torch need to make it work? Does it work better in the daytime or at night-time? Why does it work better at night-time?</p>	<p>Use crayons to draw some stars. Paint over the stars using some watery black paint.</p> <p>What happens to your picture? Can you still see the stars? Can you count how many stars there are?</p>
