Draw a picture of yourself so she will know what you look like.</p> <p>Write your name and draw the things you like to do at school. Keep the picture safe to share with your teacher when you see her.</p> <p style="text-align: center;">Sheet provided.</p>	<p>Make a card for your new teacher.</p> <p>Your teacher will be just as nervous about meeting you as you are of meeting her, so a card for her would be lovely.</p> <p style="text-align: center;">Activity Sheet provided.</p>

Remember when you write your name only the first letter must be a capital. Eg. <u>P</u>eter</p>	<p>Oh no! Lots of socks have got muddled up. Can you find the matching pairs? You could do this with real socks too. Maybe when they have been washed you could put them back in pairs.</p> <p style="text-align: center;">Sheet Provided.</p>
<p>When you go to school you may have your packed lunch or dinner there.
