Respect is one of the values that we teach the children at James Cambell Primary. Children learn about respect through the example set by adults – their parents, their families and staff at school.



In these instances, further action will be considered which may include a ban on entering the premises of James Cambell Primary School. In serious cases, the police will also be informed.

If you have any concerns about the behaviour of adults in the school, please speak to a member of staff. It is vital that we work together to teach the children about the importance of respect.
